Question #1:

Does the RPCGB intend to select one firm to contract with or multiple firms? The information on page 1 (and in other locations) of the RFP seems to indicate that the RPCGB intends to contract with one firm; however, there is a statement on page 5 of the RFP which seems to indicate that multiple firms may receive contracts: "After the short-list interviews, the Respondents that will be selected for hire will be the ones receiving the highest average rank among the selection committee members."

Answer to Question #1: 1.\textbf{Tes}, only one firm will be selected. I should have modified that part of the RFP to reflect one firm.

Question #2: Will a firm who is selected have the ability to add subconsultants for specific task orders as needed or do subconsultants need to be identified in the Response to the RFP?

Answer to Question #2: Yes, the selected firm can add subconsultants for specific task orders but you can identify the subconsultants in the proposal if you prefer.
